When I gave my life to Jesus in the year 1958 – my classmates thought I was joking. But as I continued serving the Lord, some realized that I was serious about it. Since then I have never Turned back. I therefore thank the Lord for His unfolding mercy. At school I had friends who were from Christian homes and some from non-Christian homes. I had to choose which group do I have to join because the Lord was always on my side. I had to do away with the non-believers and spent most of my time with believers. I therefore thank the Lord for His mercy that has led me up-until to-date.

Thanks so much Bob for sending me "Letters From M.O.M." volumes 23-26 for July 2007. Bob, each time one reads the Newsletters From M.O.M. volumes, one becomes so excited. I am positive that God will do miracles by both Bob and Linda. Remember the time when Mary told the people at the wedding of Cana that whatever Jesus will tell them to do, they must do it. Brother I also say, please whatever Jesus tells both of you to do, please do it.

I was looking at the amount of work you do every day. It is true that we should pray for you in order for you to continue doing this tremendous work for te Lord. Had it not been the Lord's work, I think you must have resigned. But because God gives you power, you are able to "Move On." Please know that God has put you as a model. Many people will see the Kingdom of God through you, even the Swazi people like us who have seen you.

Most important, praise be to the Lord that made you able to reach those

that are in prisons. In His Word He says “Blessed are those that visited Him while He was in jail.

Brother Bob and Linda, thank you for sending our cry for help to build God’s house where we can worship freely – to other believers across U.S.A. – especially those that saw our church condition (church building).



We do believe that God is able; He is the Lord that provides. As I mentioned in one of my letters, that the termites have started eating the scrap wood and plastics. They even build ant hills on the floor and around the building.



I also mentioned that we have already started building fund contributions. Due to sever drought that has lasted for three years now, it is very difficult for church members to make good contributions as their only source of income comes from field harvest when there is enough rain that gives them good harvest. So, our contributions are very, very slow. Our

bank account shows the sum of E 4255.89 (four thousand two hundred fifty-five Emalangeneni and eighty-nine cents). I should have included the bank branch #661164.

Needs after Release

Individuals being released from incarceration have the same common needs of all individuals. There is a need of self-respect and self esteem. Many have a need of housing. Most are coming back looking for employment. Some are facing classes for AA, NA, or Domestic Violence. Some need to enroll in educational or vocational programs. Most would appreciate someone to just talk to or have a mentor. Fellowship with the right people is ALWAYS needed. For many these are totally new expectations and experiences.

One inmate expressed wonderfully the problem of being released. He stated that everything is slow to happen while incarcerated. It seems like an eternity as you wait for your next transfer or assignment. You feel like you are running at 5 miles per hour. Then, when released to the world, you are put into an environment that is running at 200 miles per hour. This drastic change of environments tends to overcome individuals and they have a hard time adapting. We hear of transitions from one area to another in each of our lives. Someone to just talk with about the feelings and changes the individuals are going thru is a great healer. The Bible says that each of us should be a "brother" to help the other one up when he falls. Other scripture talks about "sticking closer than a brother" we can often help with sharing life experiences or just listening to someone in need. We don't always have to solve the problems, but many times need to just "lend an ear" so that someone might share their needs or hurts with us. Many men have heard from their wives "I don't want you to fix it, just listen". We need to just listen.

Sharing Your Testimony

There are 4 parts to an individual's testimony;

1. What my life was like before I met Jesus
2. How I realized I needed Jesus
3. How I committed my life to Jesus
4. The difference Jesus has made in my life.

But in reality, those who believe in Jesus have the testimony of God in them; Each of us needs to periodically share our testimony with others. The importance is not what you have done, but what God is doing.

1. Your testimony;
2. Your life lessons
3. Your godly passions
4. the Good News

Why Not Me?

Say Bob, you don't know me (really), but I know you and Linda as you know our Lord. Well, let me tell you a little about myself, without trying to write a book. It's probably the same old life you've heard and lived – Bob. Yes, I go to the chapel services every Sunday – here in Corcoran Prison. As I heard you and Linda share our good Lord's Words – at times when you came. I remember the first time I heard and read Linda's testimony (volume 15, Letter From M.O.M.), it made me feel strong all over again. Why is that? Because I know our Lord is really there for us. I too, came from a hurting & painful life that I had lived.

I was once a gang member at the age of 15 and then at age 16, became a heroin addict, as well as in-and-out of jail and prison. Playing the prison's politics, a life I had to live at times, as I was a gang member, and in the street life. So much of my life was a painful hurt to my heart. To see and be around family and close friends that passed away from gang violence or drugs. I was even with my little brother when he was 18, when he got killed. I asked God "why my little brother and not me?" For so many years I lived with the hurt and pain of my little brother's death, that I had a lot of hate in my heart, because if anyone should have died, it should have been me. I was the "black sheep" of the

family, the "bad one," the "sinner of game." I had broken all of God's rules.

But, then here I am still alive at the age of 49 years old now. I have been through so much in my lifetime. I wouldn't know where to start at with a testimony.

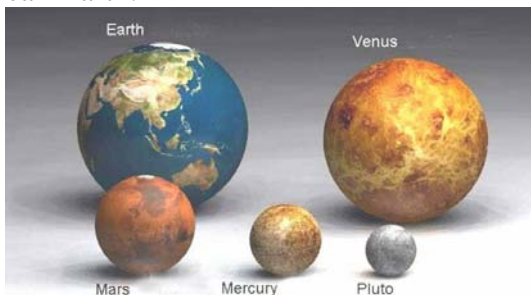
I can say one thing, now that my heart feels good and has joy; I have surrendered all to God. I accepted our Lord Jesus Christ in 1999. As I try to keep faithful to God, through this prison life, I have lived now for 8 years. I am not the best, but I came a long ways from what I was. I know God is working in my life still. That's why he kept me around. God knows I am not a quitter. I stay strong for our Lord. What His plans are for me will be in His time. I give all glory to God, because He took me away from what I once was. A gang member called Chino Sinner, and a South-sider prison sympathizer, an adulterous man, that was with a lot of women, and a drug user. This is how I lived most of my life.

I am saved, because our Lord never stopped looking for his)lost) black sheep (me). I was once lost in the dark life of sin, but now I am found and rest with love, peace, and joy. I may be in prison, but I am free inside my heart. The past of my life, is the past. I keep moving forward, and live for God now. God Bless. **JM**

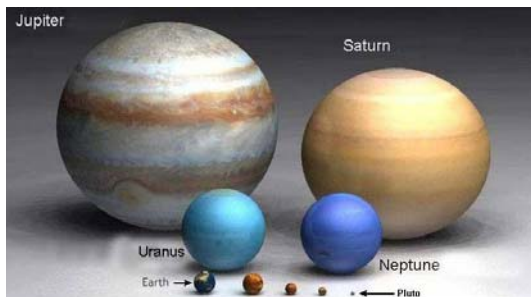
Lighter but Serious Side Significance

I would like to do a short article on “Significance.” I would like to look at “man’s” significance, when looking through Man’s eyes, and when looking through God’s eyes.

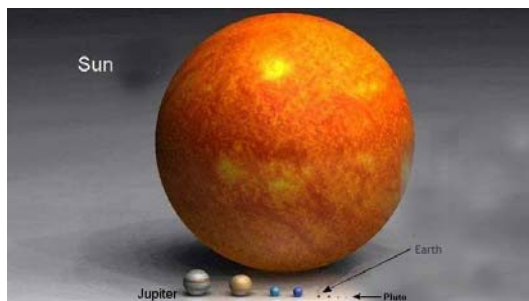
As we look at man, he is one of about 7 billion of his species on this planet, known as 3rd ball from the Sun, we call Earth.



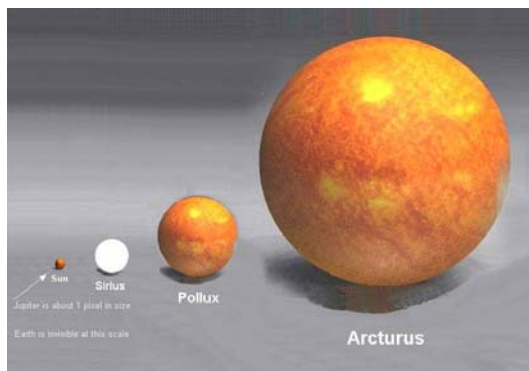
Earth is one of 9 planets (actually 8 now since Pluto has lost its status as a planet) that is larger than the other 4. The Earth is 6.55 times the diameter of Pluto



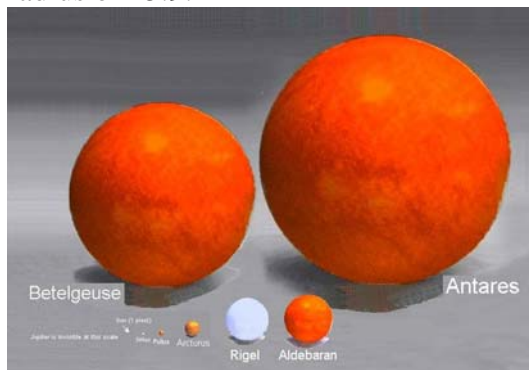
Earth is dwarfed in size, when we compare Earth to the other 4 planets, Jupiter being the largest at 11 times the Earth’s diameter.



As we compare the size of the 9 planets to our own Sun, we see that even Jupiter is dwarfed in size by our own Sun, which has a diameter of 9.68 times that of Jupiter..

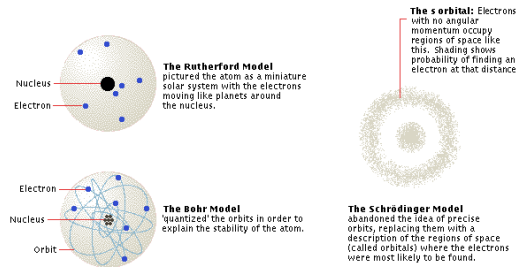


As we reach out further into space (known as the heavens), we find super stars of other galaxies. In the comparison of our Sun to Arcturus, our own sun is a mere glimmer in the presence of Arcturus, which has a solar radius of 15.9.



And yet the significance continues. Comparing Arcturus to Antares, again

makes Arcturus barely noticeable. Antares has a solar radius of 700 (700 times that of our own sun). Epsilon Aurigae is said to be 2800 times the size of our sun.



How as we look the other direction of Order and examine the atom, there seems to be the unlimited range displayed. The atom is said to have a diameter of .1 to .5 nm (10^{-8} m). The nucleus of the atom has a diameter of 10^{-12} m. The classical radius of a free proton or neutron is taken to be about 1×10^{-15} m. The radius of the free electron that orbits about the nucleus is said to be 3×10^{-15} m. The size of atomic and sub-atomic particles loses its meaning because these “particles” behave as though they are waves, or wave packets. So, “size” becomes kind of “squishy.” We would think this was the end of the structure, yet scientists discovered the “quark.” I do not know that anyone really thinks of quarks and other sub-atomic particles as having a particular “size,” in fact their masses are

usually given in energy units of c^2 from Einstein’s Theory of Relativity which states $E = mc^2$.

As we look at the lower end of the spectrum of particles such as the quarks, that are infinitesimally small and make up the other sub-atomic particles, to the opposite end of the spectrum to the giant and mega stars that are as large as solar systems, we ask how significant am I God?

Gods Word states the following;

Psalms 8:4 What is man, that thou art mindful of him? And the son of man, that thou visitest him?

Psalms 115:12 The Lord hath been mindful of us: he will bless [us]; . . .

Matthew 10:30 But the very hairs of your head are all numbered.

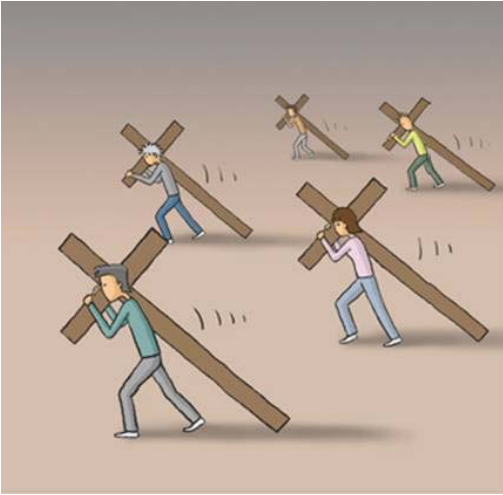
Luke 12:7 But even the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Fear not therefore: ye are of more value than many sparrows.

Realizing that God is mindful of us in this vast universe. from the sub-atomic particles such as the quarks, to the mega stellar bodies such as Epsilon Aurigae, we realize that man is significant to God. Knowing he has every detail on us (down to the number of hairs on our head) shows his attention to detail on us. And when we read of his greatest gift to us, we know of our significance because of his love displayed;

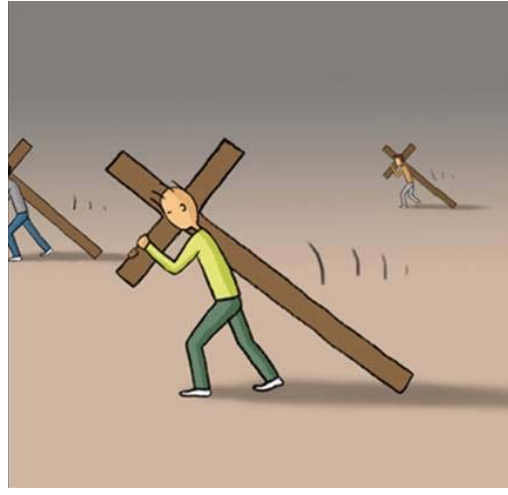

Your love and ever perfect plan.

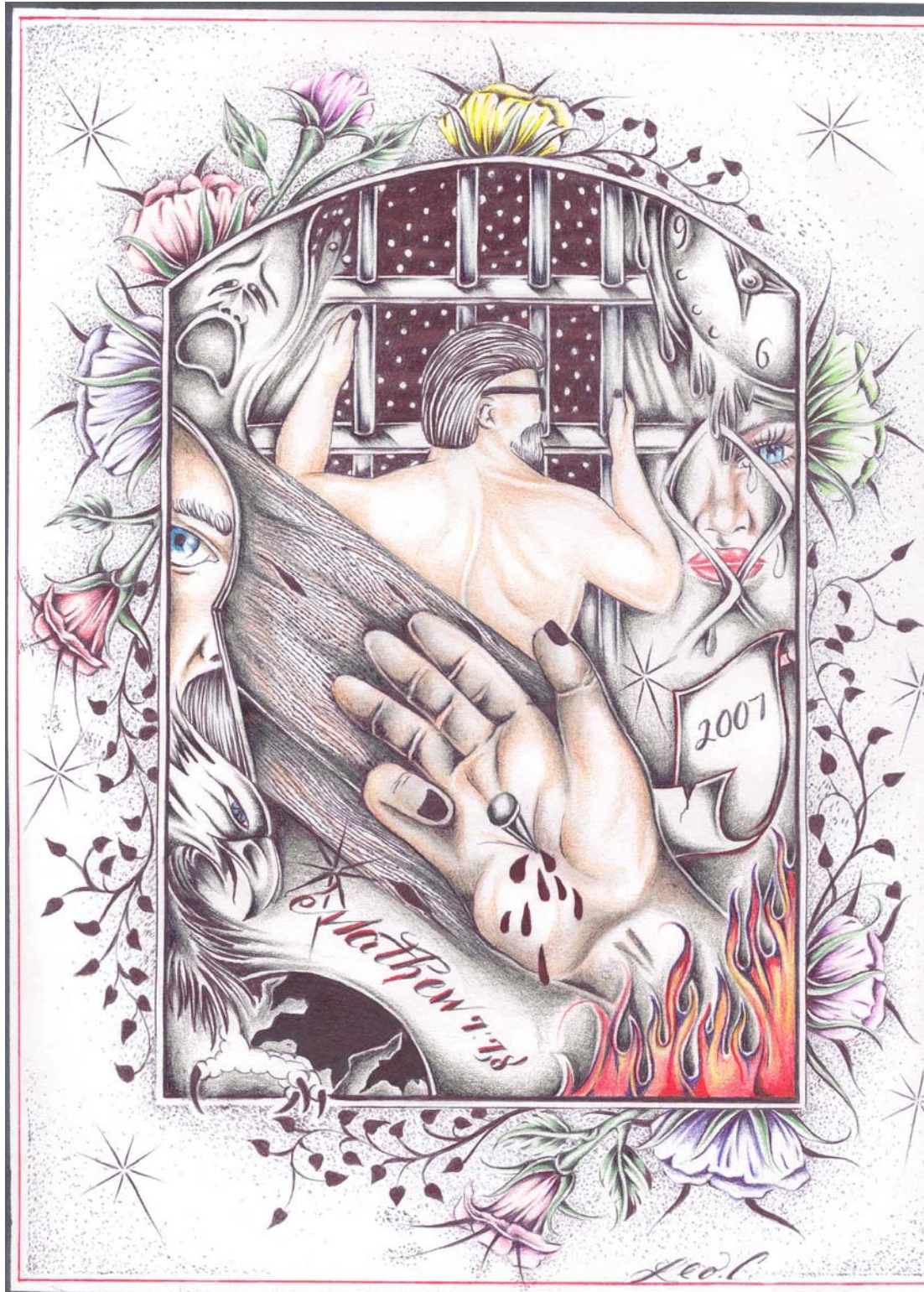

PRISONS HOLD GOD'S TREASURES

It was late and I was tired, wanting to go to sleep, but God wanted to talk; it was about midnight, but it dawned on me that God does not sleep. His question made me restless. "Bill, where on earth does man keep his most priceless treasures and valuables?" I said, "Lord, usually these treasures like gold, silver, diamonds and precious jewels are kept locked up somewhere out of sight with usually guards and security to keep them under lock and key." God spoke. Like man, My most valuable treasures on earth are also locked up." I then saw Jesus standing in front of seemingly thousands of prisons and jails. The Lord said, "These have almost been destroyed by the enemy, but these ones have the greatest potential to be used and to bring forth glory to my name. Tell MY people, I am going this hour to the prisons to activate the gifts and callings that lie dormant in these lives that were given before the foundation of the earth. Out from these walls will come forth an Army of Spiritual who will have power to literally kick down the gates of Hell and overcome satanic powers that are holding many of My own people bound in My own house.

I then saw the Lord step up to the prison doors with a key. One key fit every lock and the gates began to open. I then heard and saw great explosions which sounded like dynamite going off behind the walls. It sounded like all-out spiritual warfare. Jesus turned and said, "Tell My people to go in now and pick up the spoil and rescue these." Jesus then began walking in and touching inmates who were thronging Him.
