## How We Look at Things

Last month I wrote the following article. I mentioned that I was talking to an individual the other day and asked how they would feel if someone killed one of their children, grandchildren or great-grandchildren. She replied to me, "I would want to kill them." I said, "What about if they were not born yet?" She asked "What do you mean?" I said, "suppose that child was not born yet, but was aborted?" She just stood in silence. Now she had a different reality of what she had just said, and realized the one doing the killing would be one of her children or grandchildren.

Let me give you another example. In this case an individual is asked how many children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren they have. They mention the number of each, and you remark that they have a higher number of children than you have seen. They say that one of their children died at a younger age, yet they still count the child. Now when it comes to the

grandchildren or great-grandchildren, the aborted child is not counted. Is it amazing how we decide who counts and who does not count, rather than going by God's saying who counts. The preborn child is a '*who*' not a '*what*.' Remember the scripture says "Before you were conceived, He knew you."

Those of you who don’t know me, I’m Stephen W. and I don’t usually respond to letters written by others, but in this case I’m compelled to address the letter written by **Jerrey B.** (June 2010).

My fellow brother in Christ,  
**Jerrey B.;**

Throughout the whole New Testament there are examples of Christians being wrongly accused and hardships in spreading God’s Word. This is something Satan has done for many years and will keep doing. We, as Christians, must be stronger and keep doing God’s work.

We as Christians are not a gang, checking paperwork, sending letters to other institutions to ensure that we are men of God. What are you saying?

God does not “check paperwork,” He sees what is in the heart, for He does not judge as man judges. Being Christians, we choose to stop sinning (repent), ask God for forgiveness, have faith, and believe in His son.

Jesus came into the world to save all sinners, regardless of what they were,

so if God forgives us of our sins, shouldn’t man also forgive?

There are many verses that shows God’s forgiveness (Matt. 6:14,15; Luke 6:37; Luke 23:34; Col. 3:13; Acts 10:43, 13:38, 16:18; Daniel 9:9; Eph. 4:32) but I believe Luke 6:37 says it best – “Do not judge and you will not be judged. Do not condemn and you will not be condemned, forgive and you will be forgiven.”

I understand your concern but you must understand that we are in Satan’s playground and he will use any means possible to keep us from spreading God’s Word.

It is my opinion, formed through your letter, that you are doing Satan’s job for him by suggesting such a thing as “checking paperwork.” God checks the heart.

As Christians we grew from earthly things to spiritual things and remember growth means change, and change involves risk, stepping from the known to the unknown.

In Mathew 18:1-11 the question asked is who is the greatest in the kingdom of Heaven and Jesus answered “whoever humbles himself like this child is the greatest in the kingdom of Heaven.” Yes Jesus expresses His dislike for making a child who believes upon Jesus sin, doesn’t suggest “checking paperwork.” You are bending God’s Word to fit your needs! Be careful!

Being a Christian of a strong foundation, this will not stop my belief that my Lord and Savior, who I confess with my mouth and believe in my heart, forgave me for my sins, died the same for all who asked and believed, gave us all salvation! **Stephen W.**

## Does Salvation require Restitution or Repentance?

We always preach of the need of salvation, but today's society and religions seem to try to offer the finished product without giving the recipe. The proper pattern should be "*sorrow, repentance, forgiveness, and growth.*" Many individuals tend to skip sorrow and repentance, to try to enter into the forgiveness. Others tend to get hung up in the sorrow stage and do not go thru the repentance. Yet others never seem to enter the growth phase.

**II Corinthians 7:1** Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.

**II Corinthians 7:2** Receive us; we have wronged no man, we have corrupted no man, we have defrauded no man.

**II Corinthians 7:3** I speak not [this] to condemn [you]: for I have said before, that ye are in our hearts to die and live with [you].

**II Corinthians 7:4** Great [is] my boldness of speech toward you, great [is] my glorying of you: I am filled with comfort, I am exceeding joyful in all our tribulation.

**II Corinthians 7:5** For, when we were come into Macedonia, our flesh had no rest, but we were troubled on every side; without [were] fightings, within [were] fears.

**II Corinthians 7:6** Nevertheless God, that comforteth those that are cast down, comforted us by the coming of Titus;

**II Corinthians 7:7** And not by his coming only, but by the consolation wherewith he was comforted in you, when he told us your earnest desire, your mourning, your fervent mind toward me; so that I rejoiced the more.

**II Corinthians 7:8** For though I made you sorry with a letter, I do not repent, though I did repent: for I perceive that the same epistle hath made you sorry, though [it were] but for a season.

**II Corinthians 7:9** Now I rejoice, not that ye were made sorry, but that ye sorrowed to repentance: for ye were made sorry after a godly manner, that ye might receive damage by us in nothing.

**II Corinthians 7:10** For godly sorrow worketh repentance to salvation not to be repented of: but the sorrow of the world worketh death.

**The scripture points out repentance many times over.**

**Ezekiel 14:6** Therefore say unto the house of Israel, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Repent, and turn [yourselves] from your idols; and turn away your faces from all your abominations.

**Ezekiel 18:30** Therefore I will judge you, O house of Israel, every one according to his ways, saith the Lord GOD. Repent, and turn [yourselves] from all your transgressions; so iniquity shall not be your ruin.

**Matthew 3:2** And saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.



**Matthew 4:17** From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

**Mark 1:15** And saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel. (*Repent is prerequisite of belief*)

**Mark 6:12** And they went out, and preached that men should repent.

**Luke 13:3** I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish.

**Luke 13:5** I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish.

**Luke 17:3** Take heed to yourselves: If thy brother trespass against thee, rebuke him; and if he repent, forgive him. (*Repent is predecessor of forgiving*)

**Luke 17:4** And if he trespass against thee seven times in a day, and seven times in a day turn again to thee, saying, I repent; thou shalt forgive him.

**Acts 2:38** Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. (*Repent is prerequisite of baptism, babies have not repented*)

**Acts 3:19** Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord;

**Acts 26:20** But shewed first unto them of Damascus, and at Jerusalem, and throughout all the coasts of Judaea, and [then] to the Gentiles, that they should repent and turn to God, and do works meet for repentance.

**Revelation 2:5** Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent.

**Revelation 2:21** And I gave her space to repent of her fornication; and she repented not.

**Revelation 2:22** Behold, I will cast her into a bed, and them that commit adultery with her into great tribulation, except they repent of their deeds.

**Revelation 3:3** Remember therefore how thou hast received and heard, and hold fast, and repent. If therefore thou shalt not watch, I will come on thee as a thief, and thou shalt not know what hour I will come upon thee.

**Revelation 3:19** As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent.

**God's original intent was for an individual to make restitution with his victim. There are many examples in the Bible of restitution being 4 fold or 7 fold for replacement of the crime.**

**Exodus 22:3** If the sun be risen upon him, [there shall be] blood [shed] for him; [for] he should make full restitution; if he have nothing, then he shall be sold for his theft.

**Exodus 22:5** If a man shall cause a field or vineyard to be eaten, and shall put in his beast, and shall feed in another man's field; of the best of his own field, and of the best of his own vineyard, shall he make restitution.

**Exodus 22:6** If fire break out, and catch in thorns, so that the stacks of corn, or the standing corn, or the field, be consumed [therewith]; he that kindled the fire shall surely make restitution.

**Exodus 22:12** And if it be stolen from him, he shall make restitution unto the owner thereof.

**Job 20:18** That which he laboured for shall he restore, and shall not swallow [it] down: according to [his] substance [shall] the restitution [be], and he shall not rejoice [therein].

**Acts 3:21** Whom the heaven must receive until the times of restitution of all things, which God hath spoken by the mouth of all his holy prophets since the world began.

When we talk of believing in Christ for Salvation, it is the type of belief, that when a tightrope walker says he is going to push a wheelbarrow on the wire, across Niagara Falls, we are willing to get in the wheelbarrow.

The belief unto salvation is total commitment to God's will and turning away from all else.

The attitude we should have is worrying about "outreach" more than "income."

We should want to make all things right, not just expect God to overlook. God forgives all things, except rejection of Him.

### Notes on Newsletter Publication

We are printing in black and white to save on cost. 7<sup>th</sup> Anniversary issue should be color in Oct. 2010

Printing color requires at least 4 color cartridges for the month. The cartridges list at \$149.99, and results in an additional cost of \$600 for the month.

We print approx. 550-750 newsletters each month.

Active mailing list is 420+ and grows approx. 6 per week.

We pass out 150-350 newsletters every month.

We receive an average of 5 to 9 letters a day. Peak day is 14.

Postage averages about \$237.00 a month.

Resource Supplemental List is the hottest item requested.

We have burned out 5 color printers and 6 black and white laser printers.

Ministry is mainly financed thru Bob's paycheck.

When referring to 'staff' that would have to be the dogs, because Bob and some of Linda are the people doing (actually God) the ministry.

We do approximately 500-550 mailings a month – newsletters, resource lists, letters, and research documents.

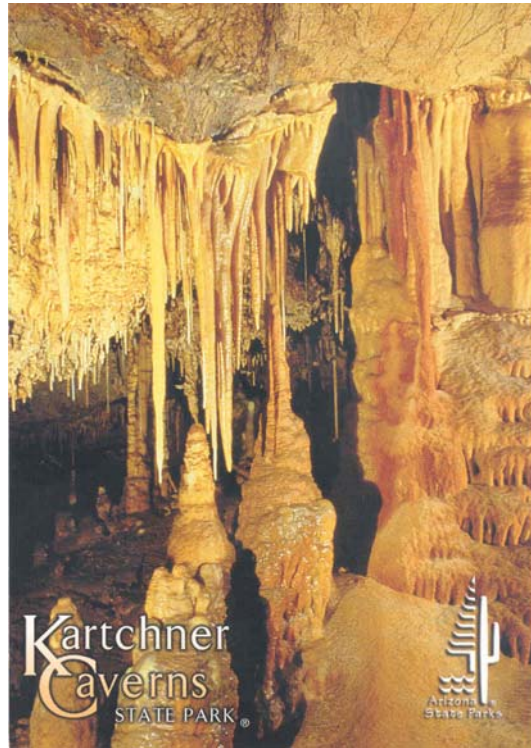

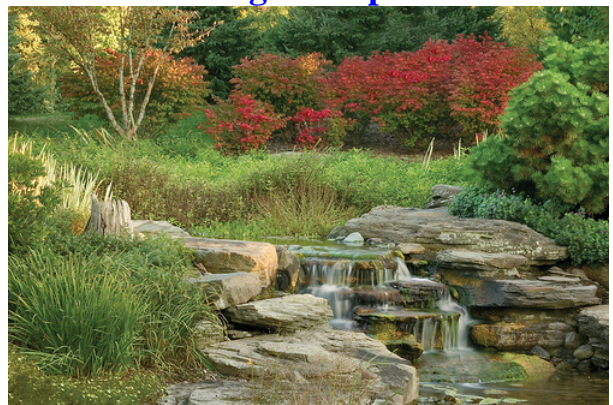

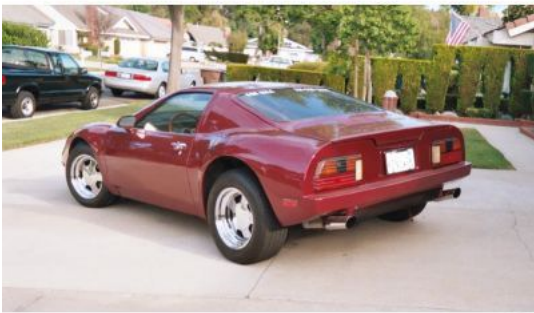

## A PAROLE PERSPECTIVE

Parole is in transition and the folks in Sacramento would be the first ones to tell you in case you didn't read it in the newspapers. But you'll experience the confusion firsthand with your first visit or two to the local parole office.

Me, I paroled on June 11 and I'm currently working with my third agent. Yes, three in two months! I haven't moved or changed my address once, still in the same place. Although I can't be certain about each of them, numbers one and two, where they're at now. And number three tells me don't get too comfortable because I'll quite soon be meeting number four! Honest!

When you hit the streets upon paroling, a job is gonna be primary on your radar, just as it was and still is for me. You're going to need both an official state identification card or driver's license, and a Social Security card. You can't get a job without 'em these days.

No longer can an employer hire you with just a printout from the Social Security office as in years past. The rules have changed, and you now must have the actual card in hand.

You can't get the Social Security card without first having a driver's license or I.D. card. Those are the rules!

A driver's license these days will set you back \$31.00, which you'll have to pay in full yourself.

An identification card, on the other hand, will run you \$25.00 and there a number of ways you can get help in paying for it. Your parole agent will give you a voucher for \$19.00 simply for the asking, making your out-of-pocket cost \$6.00. You can also get the very same voucher from the local office of Health and Human Services (welfare office) or at one of several non-profit organizations such as Proteus or C-SET.

It takes on the average of seven to ten days to get your I.D. card, and another three to six days for the Social Security card. The Social Security card is free of cost.

Again, the days when the handy computer printout would get you by are long in the past. A printout from the DMV will not get you a card at the Social Security office. Gotta have the actual I.D. card, with picture, in hand in order to apply for your social security card. Those, too, are the rules!
